



CONCORD PRIMARY MATHS CHALLENGE (CPMC) TERMS & CONDITIONS

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

By registering for the CPMC, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Failure to adhere may result in immediate disqualification.

REGISTRATION

The participation fee is RM50.00 per entry and must be paid at the time of registration. Payment receipts will be issued to parents on the day of CPMC. All information provided during registration must be accurate and complete. Parents are required to register the legal name for the cheque issuance for any prizes awarded. Concord College International School (CCIS) reserve the rights to cancel the registration if the participation fee is not received or if any information provided is found to be incorrect.

By participating in the Challenge, the Participants shall be deemed to accept the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Notice unconditionally. If the event that the Participant is not agreeable to the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Notice, the Participant must not participate in this Contest.

ELIGIBILITY

Age Requirements

- To participate in the CPMC Category 1, a student must be in Year 3 or Year 4, or below and under 9 years of age on the day of the competition.
- To participate in the CPMC Category 2, a student must be in Year 5 or Year 6, or below and under 11 years of age on the day of the competition.

RULES

- Participants are required to arrive at the CPMC venue on the stipulated dates and times, at least 15 minutes before the Maths Challenge begins. No rescheduling or second chances will be allowed if a participant fails to attend for any reason.
- No materials or digital products (e.g., reference books, pencils, mobile phones, electronic devices, calculators, digital watches etc) are permitted in the exam centre.

CHALLENGE FORMAT

The challenge is divided into 2 categories

Category 1

- Eligibility: Student must be under 9 years of age on the day of the competition
- Duration of Challenge: 40 minutes
- Question Format: Consist of 17 short-answer questions
- Language: All answers must be written in English

Category 2

- Eligibility: Student must be under 11 years of age on the day of the competition
- Duration of Challenge: 40 minutes
- Question Format: Consist of 14 short-answer questions
- Language: All answers must be written in English

REGISTRATION PERIOD

Participants may register for the CPMC from 2nd to 21st of January 2025. The deadline for registration is 21st January 2025 (Tuesday), before 5:00PM

TIE-BREAKER

There will be only one round of the contest. However, in the event of a tie in marks for the prizes, participant will be required to take part in a tie-breaker round. If a participant refuses to do so, then he/she will be disqualified from the prize, and the prize will automatically be awarded to another participant.

CHEATING AND MALPRACTICE

Any participant found to be cheating or involved in malpractice during the CPMC may be disqualified. Any disputes arising from the CPMC will be resolved by the CCIS administration, and their decision will be final. Disqualified participants will forfeit all honours, prizes, door gift and will be banned from entering CCIS premises in the future.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

- All winners on both categories will receive **Cash Prizes, Certificate of Excellence, Exclusive Concord Primary Foundation Award**, and a **Limited Edition Concord Burnell Bear**. All decisions made by the judges are final and are not subject to challenge or appeal.
- All participants will receive a **Certificate of Participation** and **Mystery Door Gifts** to honour their efforts.
- Prizes are non-transferable. Parents need to ensure the legal name is provided during registration and the cheque will be issued under the parents' name. Winners must personally collect their cash prizes at Concord College International School Malaysia before **14th of February 2025**, Friday by appointment only.

By participating in CPMC, you grant CCIS the right to use the photographs, videotapes, and participant information for educational, promotional, or identification purposes without any compensation.

CANCELLATIONS POLICY

There will be no cancellations or refunds for any circumstances.
