FOR SIXTH FORM (A-LEVEL) STUDENTS

Concord College International School sixth form students should choose a core programme of a minimum of **THREE** A-Level subjects*, which are studied for 7 periods a week, from four different columns in the list below. AS Level exams in each subject will be sat at the end of Year 12. For Cambridge International A-Level, the marks obtained will then contribute towards the A-Level grade at the end of Year 13. The one exception to this will be students taking both Mathematics and Further Mathematics A-Level, who will take the first Mathematics A-Level in Year 12.

There is also the opportunity to take an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ). This is a course equivalent to half an A-Level which offers the chance to complete a research project in an area of academic interest. Students can supplement the core three A-Level with either an EPQ (3 periods per week) or a 4th A-Level choice (7 periods), with a view to providing as much breadth in their profiles as possible. However, the additional workload required to complete 4 A-Level should be considered carefully, and most UK / US university offers will only require 3 completed A-Level. Students can choose to start with 4 subjects in Year 12, and then after taking AS Level in all 4 subjects, only continue with their strongest 3 subjects to A-Level in Year 13.

An A-Level in Further Mathematics is only available as a 4th A-Level choice (requiring an additional 5 lessons, rather than the usual 7), in combination with A-Level Mathematics in Column A, and two further A-Level choices from Columns C & D. The Further Mathematics course will be taught at an accelerated pace, and is challenging, and therefore only suitable for students with the strongest Mathematics and Additional Mathematics IGCSE results (or equivalent).

All Year 12 students will be assessed for English, and EAL students will be assigned to an English course in addition to their other academic courses leading to the IELTS English exam in Year 13, which qualifies students for university.
