Concord Primary STEAM Challenge (CPSC)

Concord College International School (CCIS) is built on a strong academic foundation that supports children's growth through a rigorous education. Concord Primary is proud to organise the Concord Primary STEAM Challenge (CPSC), which provides a safe, vibrant and supportive setting where children can explore Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) through hands-on project-based challenges.

The challenge is open to children in Years 1 to 4 (ages 5+ to 8+) and empowers young learners to discover their full potential by designing their own solutions, building their ideas into real projects, testing and refining their creations, and learning through trial, error and improvement. These skills will benefit them in school and beyond.

1. Who is eligible to participate in the CPSC?

Students currently studying in Years 1 to 4 (aged 5+ to 8+) in the 2025/2026 academic year.

2. What is the participation fee?

The participation fee is RM10.00 per participant and must be paid at the time of registration. There will be no cancellations or refunds for any circumstances. The fees include a Certificate of Participation, a Pencil Case Set, a T-shirt, and STEAM kits.

3. How many categories of Challenge are there in CPSC?

The CPSC is divided into two (2) categories. Both categories will take place on the same day.

- Category 1: Years 1/2
- Category 2: Years 3/4

4. How many seats are available in the CPSC?

The CPSC is limited to 30 participants per category, on a First Come, First Served basis.

5. What is the format of the CPSC?

- Duration: 1 hour 45 minutes, including a 20-minute snack break for participants during the Challenge
- Language: English

6. What is the focus of the CPSC?

The CPSC covers the following topics:

- Forces
- Motion
- Floating
- Energy
- Measurement

Through hands-on activities, younger participants explore concepts through experimentation, while older participants apply problem-solving and practical skills.

Step 4: Confirmation Email

You will receive a confirmation message at your registered email address once your registration is complete.

8. When is the deadline for CPSC registration?

The deadline for registration is Wednesday, 4th March 2026, at 5:00 PM (Malaysia Time).

9. When and where will the CPSC take place?

CPSC will take place on Sunday, 8th March 2026 from 10:00 AM to 13:15 PM at HEI Schools Cyberjaya.

10. What should I bring on Challenge day?

Participants must bring their original MyKid card or passport, as per the registered name.

11. Are we required to bring our own stationery?

No, stationery will be provided. No materials or digital products (e.g., reference books, pencils, mobile phones, electronic devices, calculators, digital watches etc) are permitted during the Challenge.

12. Can I obtain the project completed by the participants?

Yes, participants are allowed to keep their projects. The marking sheets will be collected and kept by the Concord Admission team and participants are not permitted to review them.

13. How are the winners determined?

Winners will be determined based on design, construction, and effectiveness.

14. When will the CPSC winners be announced?

The winners of CPSC will be announced on the same day during the Prize Giving Ceremony. Participants are required to stay for the Prize Giving Ceremony. If a participant fails to attend, his/her entry will be deemed disqualified.
