



CONCORD PRIMARY STEAM CHALLENGE (CPSC)

TERMS & CONDITIONS

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

By registering for the Concord Primary STEAM Challenge (CPSC), Participants and their parents agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Failure to adhere may result in immediate disqualification.

REGISTRATION

The participation fee is **RM10.00 per entry** and must be paid at the time of registration. Payment receipts will be issued to parents on the day of the CPSC. All information provided during registration must be accurate and complete. Parents are required to register the legal name for cheque issuance for any prizes awarded. Concord College International School (CCIS) reserve the rights to cancel any registration if the participation fee is not received or if any information provided is found to be incorrect.

By participating in the Challenge, the Participants are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Notice unconditionally. If a Participant does not agree to these Terms and Conditions or the Privacy Notice, they must not participate in this Challenge.

ELIGIBILITY

Age Requirements

- To participate in the CPSC Category 1, Participants must be in Year 1 or Year 2 (or below) and under seven (7) years of age on the day of the Challenge
- To participate in the CPSC Category 2, Participants must be in Year 3 or Year 4 (or below) and under nine (9) years of age on the day of the Challenge

Year 2 (6 years old)	Sept 1, 2018 – Aug 31, 2019
Year 3 (7 years old)	Sept 1, 2017 – Aug 31, 2018
Year 4 (8 years old)	Sept 1, 2016 – Aug 31, 2017

The Organiser reserves the right to verify eligibility and to disqualify any Participant who does not meet the eligibility criteria.

RULES

- Participants are required to arrive at the CPSC venue (HEI Schools Cyberjaya) on the stipulated dates and times, at least fifteen (15) minutes before the STEAM Challenge begins. No rescheduling or second chances will be allowed if a Participant fails to attend for any reason.
- No materials or digital products (e.g., reference books, pencils, mobile phones, electronic devices, calculators, digital watches etc) are permitted during the Challenge.

CHALLENGE FORMAT

The Challenge is divided into two (2) categories based on year group, with different levels of project difficulty. It is a hands-on challenge and does not involve written examinations.

Participants will independently design and build their projects during the Challenge. All required materials will be provided by the Organiser. An introduction, briefing, and demonstration will be conducted prior to the start of the Challenge.

- Duration: 1 hour 45 minutes, including a 20-minute snack break for Participants during the Challenge
- Language: English
- Judging Criteria: Design, construction and effectiveness

REGISTRATION PERIOD

Registration opens from 9th February 2026 to 4th March 2026. The registration deadline is Wednesday, 4th March 2026 at 5:00PM (Malaysia Time).

TIE-BREAKER

There will be only one round of the Challenge and no tie-breaker will be conducted.

CHEATING AND MALPRACTICE

Any Participant found to be cheating or involved in malpractice during the CPSC may be disqualified. Any disputes arising from the CPSC will be resolved by the CCIS administration, and their decision will be final. Disqualified Participants will forfeit all honours, prizes, door gift and will be banned from entering CCIS premises or participating in any CCIS events or activities in the future.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

- All winners on both categories will receive a **Prize Cheque, Certificate of Achievement, Exclusive Concord Merit Award,** and a **Limited-Edition Concord Burnell Bear**. All decisions made by the judges are final and are not subject to challenge or appeal.
- All Participants will receive a **Certificate of Participation,** a **Pencil Case Set,** and a **T-shirt** to honour their efforts.
- Prizes are non-transferable. Parents need to ensure the legal name is provided during registration and the mock cheque will be issued under the recipient's name as selected in the Acknowledgement Form. Winners must personally collect their mock cheque at Concord College International School Malaysia on **Friday, 13th March 2026, by appointment only**. Bank transfer will be processed within two (2) weeks following mock cheque collection.

MEDIA RELEASE

By participating in the CPSC, you grant CCIS the right to use the photographs, videotapes, and Participant information for educational, promotional, or identification purposes without any compensation.

CANCELLATIONS POLICY

There will be no cancellations or refunds for any circumstances.

PRIVACY POLICY

CCIS may use your personal information to provide challenge-related services, for marketing or educational purposes. Your personal information will not be sold to any third parties. It will be shared with third-party providers used by CCIS to the extent necessary to perform the services they provide.

CHANGES TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS
