Concord Secondary Maths Challenge (CSMC)

In line with this commitment, Concord Secondary is proud to organise the Concord Secondary Maths Challenge (CSMC) 2026. Each question in the challenge is carefully designed to assess students' analytical skills, mathematical reasoning, and application of concepts beyond routine classroom practice. The challenge is open to students in Years 7 to 11 and offers a meaningful opportunity for students to benchmark their mathematical abilities while being challenged at an appropriate secondary level.

1. Who is eligible to participate in the CSMC?

Students currently studying in Years 7 to 11 (aged 11+ to 15+) in the 2025/2026 academic year.

2. What is the participation fee?

The participation fee is RM10.00 per participant and must be paid at the time of registration. There will be no cancellations or refunds for any circumstances. The fees include a Certificate of Participation, a Pencil Case Set, and a T-shirt.

3. How many categories of Challenge are there in CSMC?

The CSMC is divided into two (2) categories. Both categories will take place on the same day.

- Category 1: Years 7/8
- Category 2: Years 9/10/11

4. How many seats are available in the CSMC?

The CSMC is limited to 50 participants per category, on a First Come, First Served basis.

5. What is the format of the CSMC?

- 40 minutes per Challenge
- All answers must be written in English
- Years 7 and 8 Mathematics paper consists of 20 multiple choice questions
- Years 9, 10, and 11 Mathematics paper consists of 20 multiple choice questions

6. What are the units of study for CSMC?

The units of study for CSMC include the following topics:

- Algebra
- Patterns
- Numbers
- Space and Shape

7. How do I register for the CSMC?

Step 4: Confirmation Email

You will receive a confirmation message to your registered email once your registration is complete.

8. When is the deadline for CSMC registration?

The deadline for registration is Wednesday, 4th March 2026, at 5:00 PM (Malaysia Time).

9. When and where will the CSMC take place?

CSMC will take place on Saturday, 7th March 2026 from 10:00AM to 05:00PM at HEI Schools Cyberjaya.

10. What should I bring on Challenge day?

Participants must bring their original MyKid card or passport, as per the registered name.

11. Are we required to bring our own stationery?

No, stationery will be provided. No materials or digital products (e.g., reference books, pencils, mobile phones, electronic devices, calculators, digital watches etc) are permitted in the exam centre.

12. Can I obtain a copy of the CSMC papers after marking?

No, participants are not allowed to keep the papers. The papers will be collected and kept by Concord Admission Team.

13. How are the winners determined?

Winners will be determined based on their accuracy and completion rate. For example, the participant who provides the most accurate answers in the shortest time will be ranked as First Place and is then continued.

14. When will the CSMC winners be announced?

The winners of CSMC will be announced on the same day during the Prize Giving Ceremony. Participants are required to stay for the Prize Giving Ceremony. If a participant fails to attend, his/her entry will be deemed disqualified.
