Concord Secondary STEAM Challenge (CSSC)

Concord College International School (CCIS) is built on a strong academic foundation that empowers students to thrive through a rigorous and forward-looking education. At CCIS, Concord Secondary adopts an interdisciplinary approach to learning, encouraging students to think critically, collaborate effectively, and apply knowledge creatively across Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM).

In line with this vision, Concord Secondary is proud to organise the Concord Secondary STEAM Challenge 2026. Designed to go beyond subject-specific knowledge, the challenge engages students in real-world problem-solving, innovation, and analytical thinking through carefully curated tasks and scenarios. Open to students in secondary year 7 to 9, the STEAM Challenge provides a meaningful platform for students to showcase their creativity, technical skills, and teamwork while developing essential competencies for future academic and career pathways.

1. Who is eligible to participate in the CSSC?

Students currently studying in Years 7 to 9 (aged 11+ to 13+) in the 2025/2026 academic year.

2. What is the participation fee?

The participation fee is RM10.00 per participant and must be paid at the time of registration. There will be no cancellations or refunds for any circumstances. The fees include a Certificate of Participation, a Pencil Case Set, a T-shirt, and STEAM kits.

3. How many categories of Challenge are there in CSSC?

The Challenge will involve only one category: Years 7 to 9 (aged 11+ to 13+). Participants will work in pairs.

4. Can participants register as a team?

Participants can register as a team by filling out the registration form individually and including their teammate's name in the remarks section. Those who do not have a teammate will be randomly paired.

5. How many seats are available in the CSSC?

The CSSC is limited to 50 participants, on a First Come, First Served basis.

6. What is the format of the CSSC?

- The theme of the Challenge is Operation Codebreaker.
- Participants will work in pairs and demonstrate teamwork while cracking four codes across different Hubs. Each Hub represents a specific STEAM element:
 - Science Hub
 - Technology & Engineering Hub
 - Arts Hub
 - Mathematics Hub
- The Challenge will run for a total of 45 minutes. Each team will have approximately 10 minutes on each Hub to crack the assigned code.
- The winning pair must successfully crack all four codes at each Hub, applying problem-solving skills, critical thinking, and creativity throughout the Challenge.

7. How do I register for the CSSC?

Send the proof of payment receipt to our Email at enquiries@concordcollege.edu.my, indicating which Challenge the participant is joining and the name(s) of the participant(s) (e.g., "CSSC, Jane Teo Li Ying"). Failure to do so will result in the registration not being recorded.

Step 4: Confirmation Email

You will receive a confirmation message at your registered email address once your registration is complete.

8. When is the deadline for CSSC registration?

The deadline for registration is Wednesday, 4th March 2026, at 5:00 PM (Malaysia Time).

9. When and where will the CSSC take place?

CSSC will take place on Sunday, 8th March 2026 from 01:45PM to 05:00PM at HEI School, Cyberjaya.

10. What should I bring on Challenge day?

Participants must bring their original MyKid card or passport, as per the registered name.

11. Are we required to bring our own stationery?

No, stationery will be provided. No materials or digital products (e.g., reference books, pencils, mobile phones, electronic devices, calculators, digital watches etc) are permitted during the Challenge.

12. Can I obtain a copy of the CSSC Challenge mission card after submitting it?

No, participants are not allowed to keep the submitted mission card.

13. How are the winners determined?

The winning pair will be the one that successfully cracks all four codes with the highest accuracy.

14. When will the CSSC winners be announced?

The winning pair of CSSC will be announced on the same day during the Prize Giving Ceremony. Participants are required to stay for the Prize Giving Ceremony. If a participant fails to attend, his/her entry will be deemed disqualified.

15. What are the prizes?

Category

Years 7/8/9

- *Cash Prize*
 - 1st Prize – Cash Prize of RM 800 (2 winners, RM800 each)*
 - 2nd Prize – Cash Prize of RM 500 (2 winners, RM500 each)*
 - 3rd Prize – Cash Prize of RM 300 (2 winners, RM300 each)*
 - Consolation – Cash Prize of RM 100 (10 winners, RM100 each)*
- *Certificate of Achievement (for ALL winners)*
- *Special Concord Merit Award (for ALL winners)*
